Basic Instructions

3.1 Batteries Setup



One set of 4 AA batteries or two sets of 4 AA batteries are required to power the lock.

3.2 System Start and Shutdown

3.2.1 Start

Make sure the batteries are properly installed, then start the system as follows:

• Scan your fingertip at the authentication lens

OR

```
• Press ENTER
```

The screen will lighten up after system start

3.2.2 Shutdown

System will automatically shutdown when not in use.

4.1 Open the Door

4.1.1 with Finger



Scan your fingertip on the authentication lens. Push the handle.



4.1.2 with Password



Enter password & press ENTER to unlock the door. Push the handle.



4.2 Close the Lock



Attention

To lock the door, you MUST pull the handle up. If not the door will not be locked.

Lock Menu

DESSMANN lock management software let you easily manage your users. Browse with the arrows keys & press **ENTER** to confirm each step.

5.1 Enter the System Menu

System can only be managed with the admin fingerprint. Start system (3.2.1) and press **MENU** twice:



Scan admin fingerprint (default: none).

- Opening Time

Change page with the arrows keys & press ENTER to exit.

Storage informs you about how many users are registered in the system and how many new users can be enrolled. Press **ENTER** to exit.

5.4.1 Set Password

Enter the last password in use and press ENTER. (Default: 888888)



Enter the new password (must be 6 digits, no more, no less), press **ENTER**, confirm it again, press **ENTER**.

5.4.2 Set Time

We recommend you to properly set the time to fully enjoy all the functions of your lock.

1.Set Password 2.Set Time 3.Unlock Mode

4.Latch Function

Set Time 10:21:25 2012/03/30

Change the values with the keypad. Press **ENTER** to confirm.

5.4.3 Unlock Mode



There are 3 modes offered by DESSMANN lock to open the door:

- Fingerprint Only Identification with fingerprint only
- Fingerprint OR Password Identification with either fingerprint OR password
- Fingerprint AND Password Identification with fingerprint AND password

5.4.4 Latch Function

Latch function let you deactivate your lock, so your door can always be opened.



- Open Your lock will always be opened, you will not need to scan your fingertip or enter your password to open the door.
- Close Your lock will function normally. You will need to scan your fingertip or enter your password to open the door.

Lock Functions

6.1 Voice Guide

A voice will guide the user when using the lock. This function cannot be de-activated.

6.2 Alarm Functions

6.2.1 Illegal Intrusion Alarm

If an illegal intrusion occurs, such a thief trying to pick-lock your door, the following will be displayed:



6.2.2 Multi-attempts Alarm

After 10 failed fingerprint authentications or 5 failed password authentications, the system will freeze for 3 minutes.

Too Many Errors Try Again Later

6.3 Batteries Low



• When the batteries are low, the lock will inform you about it & a warning message will be displayed every time your open the door.

- The lock will still operate for about 250 times after the first warning. To keep on operating your lock, replace the batteries as soon as possible.
- Check the system time after batteries replacement, because time information will be stored only for 2 days without power (require 24H of battery use first).
- Recycle the used batteries according to the related laws and regulations of your country.

6.4 Emergency Battery

In case the lock runs out of battery. You can power the system with a 9V battery.



Just plug a 9V battery on the 2 pins located below the front panel and you can operate your lock as usual. Don't forget to change your batteries afterward.

6.5 Locker Function

6.5.1 Close Position

When the locker is in the close position, nobody can open the door from outside (either with Fingerprint, Password or Mechanical Key).



6.5.2 Open Position

When the locker is in the open position, the door can be opened from the outside (either with Fingerprint, Password or Mechanical Key).



6.6 Mechanical Key

In case of system failure or damage, the lock can still be opened with a key. The keyhole is located inside the handle. To open the handle slide, grasp the handle the same way you would to open the door. Press the button situated below your little finger. It will automatically open the handle slide.



We advise you to leave the keys outside of your house, so you can get one of them in case of emergency.

6.7 Factory Reset

To delete all datas stored in the lock, proceed to a factory reset:

- 1. Open the battery cover, leave one set of 4 batteries and take one single battery out
- 2. Keep press Reset Button with the Reset Stick and re-install the battery



3. "Factory Reset?" will display on the screen, press ENTER to confirm. Factory settings are restored.



Product Warranty

DESSMANN warrants to the original purchaser that the hardware product shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for twelve (12) months from the date of purchase.

If a defect covered by this warranty occurs during this warranty period, DESSMANN or a DESSMANN AUTHORIZED REPAIR CENTER will repair the defective hardware product or component, free of charge.
